CIRCULAR

Industries are vital part of growing economy for the country. There are more than 11000 manufacturing units working in different districts of Rajasthan.


It is the responsibility of Occupier/Management of the factory to manufacture, store and transport material in safe manner to avoid any incident/accident. Responsibilities of occupier of the factory are mentioned in Factories Act, 1948. Some of the important responsibilities/duties of occupier to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all workers while they are at work in the factory are as follows:

1. Provision and maintenance of plant and systems of work in the factory
2. The arrangement in the factory for ensuring safety and absence of risks to the health in connection with the use, handling, storage and transport of articles and substances;
3. The provision, maintenance or monitoring of working environment in the factory
4. To ensure use of PPE during work
5. To ensure strict follow up of Safe Operating Procedure(SOP)

In view of the above and to move towards zero accident, Occupier/Management of the factories should take initiative to identify vulnerable locations in the factory to install CCTV camera for monitoring Safe Workplace, follow of Safe Operating Procedure(SOP), use of PPE etc. to ensure safety during manufacturing. In case of an accident the recording of CCTV may help to arrive at the exact cause and to prevent similar accidents in future.

Recording of CCTV camera should be kept for at least 30 days and should be reviewed to rectify negligence/unsafe condition.

I hope this initiative will help to improve safety of workers.
