**Order**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of section 38 of the Boilers Act, 2025, and in pursuance of the recommendations of Government of India conveyed vide letter no. P-30023/5/2026-Boiler dated 07 April 2026 regarding the impact of energy supplies due to the prevailing geopolitical situation on boiler users and the boiler manufacturing industry, and whereas it is necessary to take steps to mitigate such impact, the State Government, being satisfied that it is necessary to ensure continuity of industrial production while maintaining safety, hereby grants extension in validity of certificates for below mentioned types of boilers and following safety conditions -

1. Boilers in power plants and other higher capacity boilers (100 TPH and above steam generation capacity) requires huge oil support during stabilization of unit during cold start and backing down. For such boilers whose validity of certificate for use is expiring in the next 6 months from the date of this order, are given temporary limited extension in the validity of certificate for a further period of 3 months, subject to verification of various working parameters and satisfactory external inspection by the Competent Person under the Boilers Act, 2025.
2. To ensure un-interrupted production, for higher capacity boilers in use in major oil and gas producing units including petroleum refineries, petrochemicals as well as fertilizers plants, wherever validity of certificate for use for such boilers is expiring in the next 6 months from the date of this order, are given temporary limited extension in the validity for a further period of 3 months subject to necessary safety safeguards, verification of various working parameters and satisfactory external inspection by the Competent Person under the Boilers Act, 2025.

The owner of boiler mentioned in clause (1) and (2) shall apply online for external inspection for verification of various working parameters and necessary safeguards before expiry of certificate.
